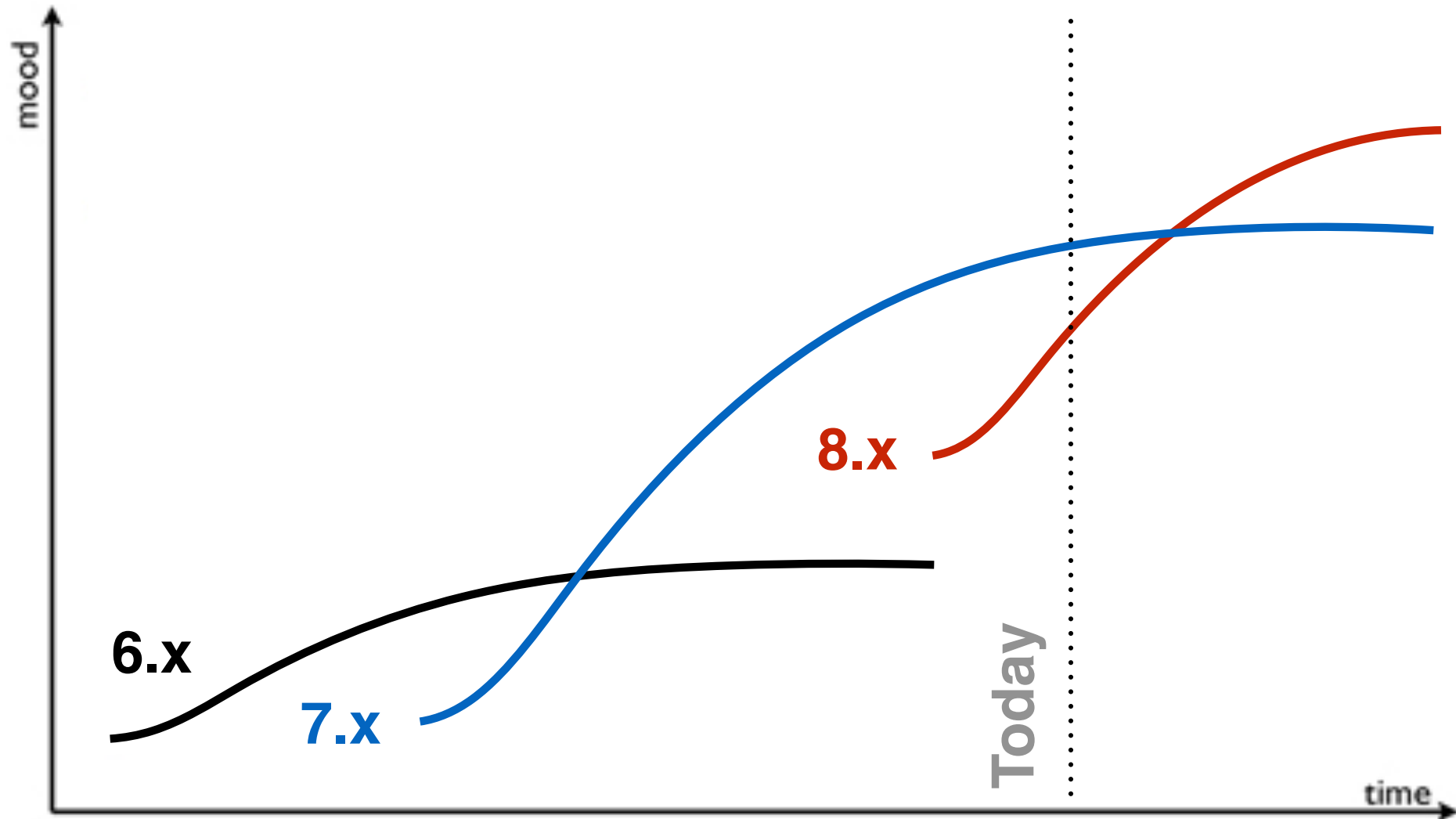

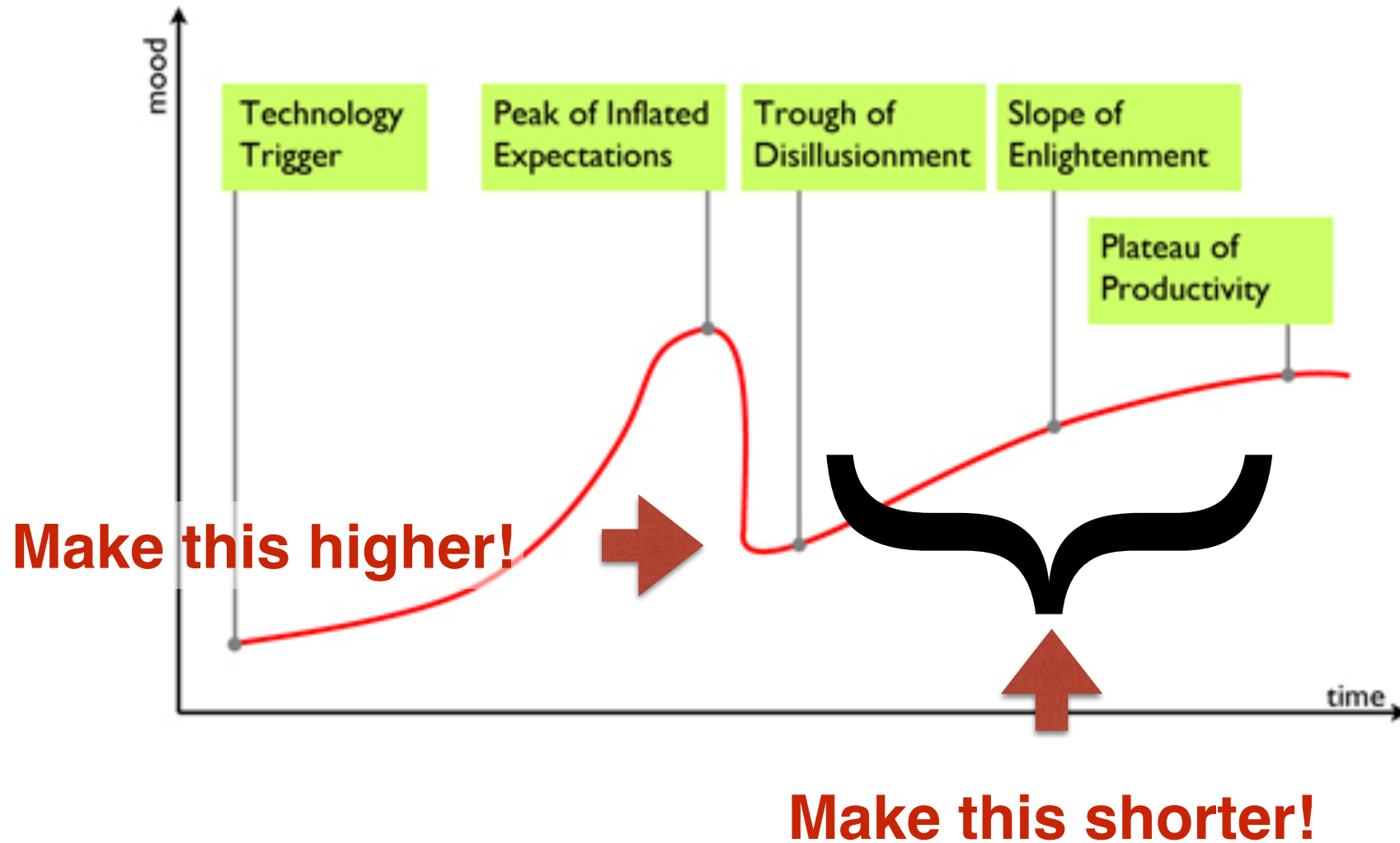

Broke APIs every 6 months! Boo!

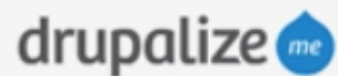
